The Student Election Program at the Maricopa County Elections, a Department of the Board of Supervisors, provides high school students access to an engaging election education program to raise their voter and civic awareness and inspire them to get involved in a fulfilling experience as a student Poll Worker. Through leadership, job skills, education, and working with their fellow community, the Student Election Program can help to make a student's future brighter.

Being a Student Election Clerk offers students at least 16-years-old to become a student Poll Worker for the Presidential Preference Primary, Primary and General Elections. If selected, students will receive \$13.85 an hour to serve as a Student Election Clerk on Election Day, gain excellent hands-on Poll Worker training with memorable experiences and receive an excused absence for performing this critical civic duty. Not to mention, this program is a great resume booster for colleges and potential employers.



### Qualifications

- Must be a U.S. Citizen (according to state law)
- Must be a high school student in Maricopa County
- Must be at least 16 years of age
- Receive permission from a legal guardian and high school administrator to participate in the program
- Ability to attend training and to work from 5:30 a.m. to after 7 p.m. on Election Day
