The Student Election Program at the Maricopa County Elections, a Department of the Board of Supervisors, provides high school students access to an engaging election education program to raise their voter and civic awareness and inspire them to get involved in a fulfilling experience as a student Poll Worker. Through leadership, job skills, education, and working with their fellow community, the Student Election Program can help to make a student's future brighter.

Being a Student Election Leader provides high school students grades 9-12 ways to participate in election education activities and is led by Certified Election Officers. In addition to learning more about elections and leadership skills, upon completion, students will have earned a certificate of completion signed by the Maricopa County Election Director.



Qualifications

- Must be a U.S. Citizen (according to state law)
- Must be a high school student in Maricopa County in grade 9 or above
- Receive permission from a legal guardian and high school administrator to participate in the program
